



## **ALBRAM CAR SCHEME**

### **VOLUNTEER DRIVERS REQUIRED**

The ALBRAM Car Scheme exists to help those patients of Alconbury and Brampton Surgeries, who cannot, whether temporarily or permanently, make their own way to medically related appointments at the surgery, hospital, clinic, optician, dentist, etc.

Details of the scheme are held at Reception at both Surgeries.

Drivers in the scheme are all volunteers who give freely of their time for the benefit of other patients. Patients using the service pay a mileage charge for each journey and a further contribution is made by Cambridgeshire County Council (CCC).

**Drivers do only as much driving for the Scheme as they wish to.**

Before being accepted as volunteer drivers, individuals are required to undergo Disclosure and Barring (DBS) checks, which are arranged by the CCC at the request of the ALBRAM Secretary, who is the coordinator for the ALBRAM Scheme.
